



Scooter Route Liverpool

Royal Albert Docks

Liverpool's docks dominated global trade in the 19th century, with the Albert Dock at their heart. Today they form part of Liverpool's World Heritage Site waterfront.

- 1 Cross over Gower Street and head for covered bridge over dock.
- 2 Wheel of Liverpool – London Eye eat your heart out!
- 3 Victorian Carousel
- 4 Maritime Museum – 4 floors of Maritime history including Titanic displays, free admission.
- 5 The Pilotage Building
- 6 Graving Docks – dry docks built in 1765, the word ‘graving’ refers to the ‘scraping’ of vessels to remove barnacles and dirt during the cleaning and repair process.
- 7 Museum of Liverpool
- 8 Back over the Swing bridge on to Kings Parade
- 9 Tate Liverpool – Modern Art Gallery, free admission.
- 10 Gower Street & The Premier Inn
