

Another classic that requires so little work, it should be a sin! All treat, no tricks.


You will need: a wire coat hanger and gold tinsel and if you really want to go deep, a golden harp but we understand that increases the cost!

Step 1: Drape the beautiful bed sheet over one shoulder and spread out both sides


Step 2: Secure both sides of the sheet, leaving one shoulder exposed

You will need:


Your trusty marker-pen and a pair of scissors
