



Your baby cot guide



While you're staying with us at Premier Inn, we want every member of the family to have a great night's sleep. As well as comfort, your safety is our main priority.

We've set up the cot ready for your stay. Please take a moment to read this guide to make sure you're familiar with the safety warnings associated with the cot.

If at any point you need to disassemble the cot, please ask a member of our team to help you set it back up correctly.

If you need any help or assistance, our reception team are available 24/7. Cellular blankets and spare nappy bags are also available at reception.

Your child's safety is our main priority.

Safety warnings:

1 Do not use if any part of the cot is broken, torn, or missing.

2 Do not use a mattress other than the one we've given you.

3 Make sure the side of the mattress can't be lifted by your child.

4 Use only one mattress in the cot.

5 Do not leave anything in the cot, or place the cot next to another product that could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation.

6 Always keep your child in view and never leave them unattended.

7 Duvets and pillows shouldn't be used in the cot.

8 For children under 15kg and 86cm in height who aren't able to climb out.

9 Keep the cot away from a radiator or heater.

10 Use for sleeping only (no play pens!).

11 To sleep only one child under 3 years of age per cot.

12 Keep the cot on the floor.
